Thanks for the reply. You have not responded to the legal regulations you use to monitor air quality and to define types of pollutants, limit values and other air quality standards. According to your report on air pollution in the world in 2018 in Europe Gračanica is the third most polluted town (page 14). From your answer is evident that all the analysis of pollution based on a single measurement point for which you did not have accurate information on the location. Your answer about replacing locations SKVER is inadequate. Square is part of the urban settlements are parts of cities often call the name of Square.

On your website, you did not give an explanation of how you came to the data and how you processed them. Your data on air pollution used the news media and spread false information about air pollution in Gračanica. The data on the websites: [monitoringzrakatk.info/skver.html](http://monitoringzrakatk.info/skver.html) and [//www.fhmzbih.gov.ba/latinica/index.php](http://www.fhmzbih.gov.ba/latinica/index.php) regularly monitor. These data do not indicate a high air pollution in Gračanica.

The Municipality of Gračanica asks you to publish on your website that inaccurate air pollution data for Gračanica has been published and to make a correction promptly in your air quality reports.
